This course, hosted by Professor Alyson Simpson from the University of Sydney, will illuminate Australian children's literature and is suitable for anyone curious about quality stories for our young and how to promote the appreciation and enjoyment of children's literature*

### ■ FOUR-WEEK ONLINE COURSE - APRIL 21 TO MAY 18, 2023

The course will run **online over four weeks** using a Canvas learning management system and will include extensive resources.

**Each week** you will have access to a **one-hour pre-recorded lecture** (broken into chunks), using real-world examples that relate to CBCA Book of the Year Award categories and criteria, **plus** four one-hour Zoom webinars to discuss weekly topics.
